Death Results From Complications After Childbirth Two Weeks Ago

Funeral services for Mrs. William Greub, 34 years old, Monroe, well known in Monticello, who passed away at 7 o'clock Sunday morning in the Monroe hospital from complications developing from childbirth two weeks ago, were conducted privately at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon in the home and at 2 in St. John's Evangelical church, Monroe. Rev. P. A. Schuh officiated and burial was in Highland cemetery, Monticello.

The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Legler, Miss Clara Legler was born March 28, 1895, in Argyle township, three miles northwest of Argyle. She attended the Argyle schools, but for the past nine years had resided in Monroe. She resided for two years with her uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. J. C. Steinman, Sr., Monticello, and during her stay here made many friends,

She was united in marriage to William Greub, Monroe garage owner and formerly employed here, on April 6, 1926.

Survivors besides the widower are the infant son; her mother, Mrs. Magdalena Legler, Monroe and two brothers, William Legler Monroe, and Ernest Legler, Argyle.
