

**Walter Haddinger**  
**Aug. 16, 1906, - April 6, 1981**

Walter Haddinger, 74, Rt. 1, Belleville, died Monday, April 6, 1981, in his home. His death, believed caused by a heart attack suffered earlier in the day, was discovered Monday. He lived alone.

He was born in Clarno Township, Green County, Aug. 16, 1906, to William J. and Lydia Lehnherr Haddinger. He never married. He had farmed, first on the Haddinger home farm in Mt. Pleasant Township until 1939 when he moved to Monticello. He resumed farming in 1958 when he moved to a smaller farm in Exeter Township, residing there since.

Surviving are two brothers, Fred Haddinger of Ft. Atkinson, and Ray of Albany, and nieces and nephews.

Preceding him in death were his father in 1949, his mother in 1966; three brothers, Herman, 1936, Willis, 1948, and Harry, 1976; and a sister, Alice, in 1973.

Mr. Haddinger was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and the following Masonic orders: Albany Lodge No. 36 F. & A.M., Monroe Commandery No. 48 Knights Templar, Gebal Council No. 2 R & S.M., the New Glarus Chapter 108 R.A.M., Life member of the Madison Scottish Rite Bodies, Life and P.M.C. member of Zor Temple AAONMS of Madison and member of the New Glarus Chapter 225 Order of Eastern Star.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday in Gohlke-Sharer Funeral Home, Albany, the Rev. Charles G. Workman of Zwingli Church, Monticello, officiating. Interment will be in Hillcrest Cemetery, Albany. Friends may call Wednesday from 7 to 9 p.m. at the funeral home where Masonic services will be held at 8 p.m.
