MONTICELLO — Mrs. A. Marie Hammerli, 97, formerly of Monticello, died at 8:35 am. Tuesday, Aug. 13, 1985, at the New Glarus Home, where she had been a resident since May 8, 1975.

She was born at Waggital, Canton Schwyz, Switzerland, May 26, 1888, the daughter of Pius and Caroline Machler. She received her education in Switzerland, and was married March 6, 1913, to John Hammerli in Switzerland. They came to the United States shortly after their marriage, where they farmed in Washington Township near Monticello for more than 30 years.

They retired to Monticello in 1941.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Frank (Emma) Nussbaum, Monroe; five grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Hammerli was preceded in death by her husband in 1954, a son, Walter, in 1971; two half-brothers, Daniel and Pius, both in Switzerland; a sister, Mrs. Albert (Caroline) Elmer, Albany; and two half-sisters, Regina and Alberta, both in Switzerland.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello, the Ladies Aid Society, and the G.U.G.G. lodge.

Funeral services will be at 11 am. Friday at the Zwingli United Church of Christ with the Rev. Erwin H. Pegel, church pastor, officiating. Interment will be in the Highland Cemetery in Monticello.
