

Fred C. Hammerly

Fred C. Hammerly, 82, of 104 N. Taylor St., Albany, died unexpectedly Tuesday, Oct. 16, 1979, at 1:05 a.m. in his home.

He was born in Green County on Oct. 17, 1896, the son of Casper and Elise Zimmerli-Hammerly. He attended Green County rural schools.

On May 5, 1920, he was married at Monticello to the former Maud V. Legler by the late Rev. Muehlmeier. After their marriage they farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township. Retiring from farming in 1948, they have resided in Albany since 1949.

Survivors include his wife; one son, Ralph F. Hammerly, Monticello; one daughter, Mrs. Clarence (Lois) W. Marty, Madison; one sister, Mrs. Kenneth (Wilma) Lovell, Monroe; six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

Mr. Hammerly was preceded in death by his father in 1912 and his mother in 1952 and one sister, Mrs. Anna Pagel, who died May 9, 1973.

He was a member of the Albany Senior Citizens and the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello,

Mr. Hammerly and his wife observed their 50th wedding anniversary in May of 1970. Hammerly was an avid fisherman.
