

ALICE E. HAURI

June 3, 1915 - September 27, 1998

Alice E. Hauri, age 83, a resident of Graceland Manor III, Monroe, and formerly of St. John's Garden Apartments, died Sunday, September 27, 1998 at the Monroe Clinic Hospital.

Alice was born June 3, 1915 near Mt. Vernon in Dane County, daughter of Marshall and Eliza (Everill) Abbott. She married Walter Hauri on October 27, 1934 in Monticello. He preceded her in death on June 29, 1977.

Mrs. Hauri attended New Glarus grade schools. She farmed with her husband in the Monticello area until moving to Monticello in 1957. She lived in Monticello until entering St. John's Garden Apartments in 1981. Alice was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ, Monroe, and formerly a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.
