Irene Hauri Feb. 3, 1903 – April 1929

LAST RITES FOR MRS. W. HAURI, 26, HELD THIS AFTERNOON; BRIEF ILLNESS RESULTS IN DEATH MONDAY

Funeral services for Mrs. Walter Hauri, 26 years of age, whose death occurred here about 1:30 o'clock Monday morning in the home of her parents, were held this afternoon at 1:30 in the home and a half hour later in the Reformed church.

The services were conducted by the Rev. A. Muehlmeier, pastor of the church. Interment was in Highland cemetery.

The death of Mrs. Hauri came with shocking suddenness. She was apparently in her usual health Saturday morning when she suddenly became violently ill. She lapsed into unconsciousness and her condition grew worse, with the result that Sunday practically all hope for her recovery was abandoned. The end came peacefully early Monday morning.

Her maiden name was Irene Floy Blum and she was the only child of Mr. and Mrs. Fred A, Blum, having been born Feb. 3, 1903, in Washington township. She attended the county rural schools and was also a student at the Monticello public schools until impaired health forced her to abandon her education. Her marriage to Walter Hauri took place in Monticello on October 2, 1924.

Mrs, Hauri was a devoted member of the Reformed church which she attended regularly and faithfully. She was an unusually willing and conscientious worker for the welfare of her church and, with. the exception of when her health interfered, taught one of the Sunday school classes.

Mrs. Hauri was affiliated with the Ladies Aid and Missionary societies of the church. She was confirmed with the class of 1918.

The passing of this worthy young woman has brought poignant grief to the bereaved parents and husband who are overwhelmed with sorrow over her sudden and unexpected demise. Mrs. Hauri was a young woman whose sterling qualities were evidenced in many ways. She was always held in high esteem by those who knew her and the announcement of her death brought sadness to many friends in this vicinity and elsewhere.

Survivors are the husband and parents,
