MONTICELLO — Charles E. Hefty, 81, former Mount Pleasant Township, Monticello resident, died Monday, Jan. 16, 1995 at Lakeland Nursing Home, Elkhorn, where He has resided since August 1994. He was born March 8, 1913 in . Mount Pleasant Township, the son of John J. and Anna K. (Freitag) Hefty.

He was a 1930 graduate of Monticello High School and a graduate of Platteville State Teachers College.
