Henry C. Hefty, 68, Monticello, died unexpectedly Thursday, June 9, 1978 at his home.

He was born on the Hefty homestead in Washington Township on Feb. 18, 1909 the son of Edward and Susanna (Stauffacher) Hefty. He was a graduate Monticello High School in 1926. On Feb. 24, 1938 was married to the former Florence Holcomb. He farmed until his retirement in 1960, living in Washington Township.

Funeral services were held Monday, July 3 in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated. Burial was in Highland Cemetery.
