Donald L. Hoesly, age 63, of Winslow, IL, formerly of Monticello, died on Wednesday, May 22, 2002. He was born on March 22, 1939 in Monroe, the son of Walter and Ruth Hoesly. He was a graduate of Monticello High School. Donald and Judy Gibbons were married on July 16, 1960. He owned and operated the Casino supper club and Village Tap in Monticello. Donald later worked for Curran's cheese Plant and did maintenance and carpentry work in the area. He entered the US Navy on August 5, 1958 and was discharged on July 20, 1962 as an Aviation Machinist Mate 2nd Class.
