

MRS. IDA HOESLY

Feb. 28, 1892 - Sept. 14, 1978

Mrs. Ida Hoesly, 86, New Glarus, formerly of Monticello, died Thursday, Sept. 14, 1978 in St. Clare Hospital, Monroe, where she had been a patient since Sept. 3.

She was born in Exeter Township on Feb. 28, 1892, the daughter of Matt and Emma (Bloom) Voegeli. She attended Wallace rural school, and was married to Wilbert S. Hoesly on Dec. 22, 1915 in Monticello. They farmed west of New Glarus for a short time, then moved to Monticello. Her husband was a former businessman in Monticello. He died on Nov. 10, 1957. Mrs. Hoesly had lived in Monticello until 1972, when she moved to New Glarus.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Sept. 16 in the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where she was a member. Rev. Charles G. Workman, officiated. Burial was in Highland Cemetery.

She was also a member of the Women's Relief Corps of Monticello and the New Glarus Chapter of the Order of Eastern Star. ‘
