

MARGARET I. HOLCOMB

Margaret I. Holcomb, age 95, of Monroe, died Monday, July 19, 2004 at St. Clare Friedenshiem Assisted Living, Monroe.

Margaret was born January 18, 1909 in Oberried, Switzerland, the daughter of Arnold and Ida (Amacker) Brunner. She married Arthur Holcomb on January 18, 1928 at St. John's United Church of Christ, Monroe.
