Margaret A. Huntley age 84 of Brodhead died Wednesday, November 16, 2011, at Mercy Hospital in Janesville following complications from heart surgery.

Margaret was born November 27, 1926 in Rockford, IL, the daughter of William and Viva (Barker) Hoeft.

She attended Monroe High School and earned her G.E.D. at the age of 53. She married Leland S. Huntley on December 4, 1943 at the Zwingli UCC in Monticello.
