

Mrs. Leona Isely, 58, Argyle, Stricken

Jan. 19, 1908 – Feb. 21, 1965

Mrs. Willis Isely, 58, Adams Township farm wife, died yesterday afternoon of a heart attack in the office of an Argyle physician. She had had a heart condition several years.

Mrs. Isely was the former Leona Hefty, daughter of Henry and Ida Lynn Hefty. She was born in Washington Township Jan. 19, 1908 and attended Loveland and Monticello High Schools. On Nov. 28, 1928, she was married in the Monticello Zwingli Church to Willis Isely.

For four years after their wedding they farmed in Washington Township. Since then they have been in Adams Township.
