Rose A. Isely, 95, of 1803 20th St. died Thursday, July 10, 1986, at the Monroe Manor Nursing Home.

Born July 16, 1890, in Washington Township, Green County, she was the daughter of Jacob and Rosina (Schmid) Isely. She attended schools in Richland County and worked as a practical private-duty nurse in the Freeport area until retiring in 1974. After her retirement she came to Monroe and since resided with her niece and her niece's husband, Muriel and Glenn Benkert, until entering the Manor in November of 1985.
