

Wm. Jordan, Jr.

April 18, 1868 – 1917

Wm. Jordan, Jr, passed away at 10 o'clock on Friday morning last, after an illness of only a few days duration, His death occurred at the home of his parents, Mr and Mrs Wm. Jordan, Sr, and came as a severe shock to relatives and friends alike, as few were aware but what he was in his usual health. He suffered from a complication of la grippe and heart trouble, his condition being such that for two or three days preceding the end he was unable to lie down. Dissolution occurred suddenly as he was being removed from one chair to another. Wm.

Herman Jordan was born in Monticello on April 18, 1868, and had spent all of his life in this village. He was married on October 27, 1896, to Miss Esther Date, and was the father of two children, Harold and Mercedes, now living in Chicago, both of whom survive him. He was well known in and around Monticello and enjoyed the friendship of a large circle of acquaintances because of his good natured and jovial disposition.

Besides his family and his aged parents, he is survived by two brothers, Fred and Charles A. Jordan, both of Monticello. Funeral services were held at the family home shortly before 1 o'clock Sunday afternoon, the Rev. A. Muehlmeier, pastor of the Reformed church, officiating. A large number of relatives and friends were present at the last sad rites, many of them being from a distance. Interment was in Highland cemetery.
