

KERMIT D. KAMMERER

Kermit D. Kammerer, age 95, of Monticello, died Sunday, January 1, 2006 at the New Glarus Home.

Kermit was born on April 22, 1910 in Brodhead, Wisconsin, the son of Louis and Amelia (Maurermann) Kammerer. He graduated from Brodhead High School in 1928 and attended Janesville Business College.

Kermit married Dorthea Veek on March 28, 1935 in Rockford, IL. They made their home in Brodhead before moving to Monticello in 1942.

Kermit worked for Ties Oil Co. of Brodhead for five years, Green County Farm Bureau for twenty-five years, Advance Transformer for eleven years, and Blanchardville CO-OP for eight years before retiring.

He was a faithful member of Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello where he was Head Usher for 50 years, served on the Church Consistory for 18 years and belonged to the Men's Brotherhood,

Survivors include three children, Janet (Harvey) Wolter, Venice, Florida, Margaret Leonard of Skokie, Illinois and Rodney Kammerer of Juda: six grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Dorthea, on April 18, 1998: his parents; one brother and six sisters.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, January 6, 2006, at 11:00 am., at Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello. The Rev. Lawrence Balleine will officiate with interment in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
