

LEON W. KLASSY

Leon W. Klassy, 71, Argyle, former Monticello resident, died Nov. 30, 1981 in Darlington.

He was born on Sept. 6, 1910, the son of William E. and Louisa Bidlingmaier Klassy. He attended Klassy rural school and Monticello High School. On August 18, 1964, he was married to Margaret Chamberlin in Nashua, Iowa. He lived in Monticello most of his life, moving to Argyle in 1975.

Mr. Klassy had been in partnership with his father in Klassy Milling Company in New Glarus. He also operated a portable mill and trucking business. In later years he became interested in gardening.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, Dec. 3, at 1:30 pm. in the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, with Rev. Charles Workman officiating.

Survivors include his wife, Margaret; his mother, Mrs. Louisa Klassy, the New Glarus Home; one step-daughter, Mrs. John (JoAnn) Winzenried, Monticello; one sister, Mrs. Werner (Lillian) Hefty, Monticello; one brother, Roger Klassy, New Glarus; three step-grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his father in 1967 and a nephew, William Hefty, in 1961.
