ALBANY—Mrs, E. Q. Knapp, 88, died at 2:30 p.m. Saturday in Oelwein, Ia. She suffered a fractured hip in a fall earlier in the week. She and her husband operated a country store in Attica for many years, retiring in 1920.

The former Alice Ramsay, daughter of Alexander and Mary Nolan Ramsay, was born in Glen Haven Dec. 29, 1866. She was married to Edmund Knapp May 27, 1882. They moved to Oelwein following their retirement from business in Attica and Mr. Knapp died March 4, 1937,

Survivors are a son, Clyde, Chicago; a daughter, Mrs. Fay Bartlett, Albany; 11 grandchildren and 33 great-grandchildren. Two sons, Winfred and Leon, preceded her in death.
