FELL FROM A LADDER,

Jacob Kubly, of Monticello, Injured and Died.

Jacob Kubly, of Monticello, an old resident of Green county and between 50 and 60 years of age, was found lying dead on the floor at his residence Thursday afternoon. It was found that his right arm and two ribs were broken, and there was a bad bruise on his head. Mr. Kubly got home between the hours of 12 and 1 o'clock and soon after his arrival it is supposed he climbed up a ladder on the outside of the house to go into the garret and fell with fatal force. The Jury rendered a verdict accordingly, He leaves three sons and two daughters. The funeral was held Sunday.
