


Robert O. Kubly

Robert O. Kubly, age 82 of Monticello, died at his home on Sunday, May 29, 2016 following a long battle with pancreatic cancer. Robert was born November 17, 1933 in Spring Grove Township, the son of Fredrick O. and Madeline (Pfister) Kubly. He married Shirley Schwartz on November 17, 1953 at St. Johns United Church of Christ, Monroe.
