


Fred H. LaRosh

Fred H. Larosh, age 76 of Monticello, died Sunday, July 19, 2015 at his home following a long illness. Fred was born May 19, 1939 in Pekin, IL, the son of Rollo and Estella LaRosh. He graduated from Pekin Community High School and attended the University of Illinois. Fred and Ellen E. Wineburner were married on October 18, 1958 in Pekin. Fred farmed in Washington Township for 20 years and also had a hay trucking business.
