Conduct Rites for Resident of Attica

Mrs. Theopolis Lewis, 76, Expires After Long Illness

Funeral services for Mrs. Theopolis Lewis, 76 years of age, native of Washington township, who passed away at 6 p. m. Thursday in her home about two miles west of Attica, after an illness of a year and a half, were conducted at 2 Sunday in the Methodist church, Albany, the Rev. H.. CG Pierstorff, officiating. Interment was in the Hillcrest cemetery.

The couple had lived for some time in Henry county, Tennessee, and Harlan county near New Orleans, La. They came to the Monticello vicinity 41 years ago. They had resided on their farm on the Monticello-Attica road for many years.
