MONTICELLO — Mrs. Dorothy M. Loveland, 82, 580 S. Main St., Monticello, died Sunday, June 29, 1986, at St. Clare Hospital in Monroe. She had been a patient there since June 17.

She was born Sept. 30, 1903, in Washington Township, Green County, the daughter of Roscoe and Lena (Juingst) Smith. She attended Loveland Rural School and was married Oct. 9, 1933, to Clarence W. Loveland at Monroe. After their marriage, the couple farmed on the Loveland Homestead Farm in Washington Township until 1956, when they retired and moved to Monticello.

Mrs. Loveland was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ and the Friendship Circle, New Glarus Order of Eastern Star and the former Washington Homemakers Club.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Clarence, in 1979; one sister, Mrs. Oscar (Phyllis) Losey, in 1955; a brother, Richard M. Smith, in 1979 and a brother in infancy in 1902.

Funeral services will be at 11 am. Wednesday at the Zwingli United; Church of Christ, with the Rev. Erwin H. Pegel officiating. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
