

Frank Loveland

Frank J. Loveland, 70, lifelong Monticello area resident, died today, Sept. 14, 1977, at 1:15 am. in Pleasant View Nursing Home after a long illness.

Mr. Loveland had been in failing health the past four years and had been hospitalized in Madison at different times and was a patient at Pleasant View in 1976 for a period of time. He was re-admitted to the nursing home on April 26, 1977.

Born on the Loveland Homestead Farm in Washington Township on Sept. 2, 1907, he was the son of Otto and Fanny Moritz Loveland. He attended Loveland rural schools. He was married on May 17, 1928, in the Zwingli Church Parsonage in Monticello to the former Hilda R. Zimmermann by the late Dr. Albert Muehlmeier. After their marriage they farmed in Washington Township. In 1958 they moved to Monticello where he was engaged in carpentry.

Surviving are his wife; a niece, Mrs. Gretchen Morgensen, Madison, who was raised by Mr. and Mrs. Loveland; a brother, Clarence W. Loveland, Monticello; and nieces and nephews.

Mr. Loveland was preceded in death by his father on March 10, 1930, and his mother on July 31, 1951.

He was confirmed on March 20, 1921, in Washington Reformed Church. He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.

Mr. Loveland, whose hobby was restoring and operating steam and gasoline powered engines, was an active member of the Rock River Threshere, Edgerton. He was a former member of the Loveland School Board District and a former director and for a short time president of the Mt. Pleasant Mutual Insurance Co.

Services will be Saturday, Sept 17, at 1:30 pm. in the Zwingli United Church of Christ. Rev. Charles G. Workman will officiate.

Friends may call on Friday from 5 to 8 pm. at the Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge and on Saturday morning until time of services. Interment will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello. Voegeli Funeral Service is in charge of arrangements.
