

HILDA LOVELAND

Mrs. Hilda Loveland, 83, a former Monticello resident, died Thursday, Dec. 21, 1989, at the New Glarus Home, where she was a resident for the past two years.

The former Hilda Rosetta Zimmerman was born in Washington Township, Green County, Aug. 29, 1906, the daughter of Albert and Annie (Blumer) Zimmerman. She attended the Purcell rural school in Washington Township.

She married Frank J. Loveland May 17, 1928, in the Zwingli United Church of Christ parsonage in Monticello. The couple farmed in Washington Township until retiring to Monticello in 1958.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ and the Friendship Circle of the church.

Survivors include a niece, Mrs. Gretchen Morgensen, Madison, who was raised by the Loveland's; three brothers, Albert; New Glarus, and Amos and Harold, both of Monticello; and a sister, Mrs. Leona (Ivan) Marty, Monticello.

Preceding her in death were her husband, Sept. 14, 1977; three sisters, Edna Schuler, Mildred Williams and Clara Weissmiller; and two brothers, Clarence and Walter.

Funeral services were held Tuesday in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, the Rev. Erwin H. Pegel officiating. Burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
