

Fred W. Luchsinger

MOUNT HOREB — Fred W. Luchsinger, age 86, of Mt. Horeb, formerly of Monticello, died Saturday, May 13, 2000 at Ingleside Nursing Home in Mt. Horeb.

Fred was born February 7, 1914 in Paoli, Wisconsin, son of Fred W. and Euphemia (Marty) Luchsinger Sr. He married Hazel E. Bear on October 10, 1940 at the Monroe Emmanuel Evangelical Church. She preceded him in death on October 14, 1989.

Following their marriage Fred and Hazel farmed in the Monroe area for several years and in 1952 they purchased a farm in Washington Township, near Monticello, where they farmed until retiring in 1975. Mr. Luchsinger had been a resident of Ingleside since May 1998.

He was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.
