James Mahar, Native of Exeter Twp., Dies

Final rites for James Mahar, 59 years of age, native of Exeter township, who passed away at 2:45 Wednesday morning in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Jerome Garvoille, Exeter township, following a period of failing health which was aggravated by heart trouble, were conducted at 9:30 Friday morning in the Garvoille home and at 10:30 in St. James Catholic church at Dayton. Rev. A. J. Reinl officiated and burial was in Calvary cemetery at Monroe.

Pallbearers were Arthur Doyle, Roy Staley, A. B. Carroll, A. D. Carroll, Jacob Buol and John Q'Connor.

Born June 11, 1871, Mr. Mahar was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Mahar. He was united in marriage to Miss Nellie Keating at Monroe April 20, 1903. For many years he was engaged in farming. Mr. Mahar was affiliated with St. James Catholic church and the Sugar River Camp of the Modern Woodmen of America.
