Washington Citizen Passes From Stroke

Mrs. Theodore Marty, 44, Summoned: Funeral Rites Held

Funeral services for Mrs. Theodore Marty, 44 years of age, who died suddenly at 8:30 Monday morning in her home in Washington township, were conducted in the Marty home at 1:30 Wednesday afternoon with burial in the Reformed cemetery, New Glarus. Services were conducted in the Evangelical and Reformed church following rites at the grave. Rev. Richard Rettig, pastor of the church, officiated.

Mrs. Marty had called on friends in New Glarus Sunday and apparently was in the best of health. That evening she was taken ill suddenly and when her husband entered the home that evening he found her unconscious on the floor. A physician was called. A stroke was believed to have been the cause of her sudden demise.

Anna Marie Hefty was born in New Glarus township March 3, 1892, the daughter of Melchior and Catherine Hefty. On March 10, 1910, she was united in marriage to Theodore Marty, the ceremony taking place in New Glarus. Following their marriage, the couple lived on a farm five miles south of New Glarus.

Survivors, besides the widower are three daughters, Mabel, Olga and Mary, one son, Theodore, Jr.; her father; three sisters, Mrs. William Marty, Mrs. Thomas Ott and Mrs. Herman Marty, all of New Glarus; and two brothers, Jacob and John Hefty, both of New Glarus township. She was preceded in death by her mother.
