

Barbara Marty

1854 – 1923

The grim reaper, death, brought to a close a long and useful life on Tuesday of this week, when Mrs, Barbara Marty, widow the late Paul Marty, succumbed to a stroke of paralysis at her home on Coates street. The news of her sudden and unexpected death came as a severe shock to the entire community, as but very few were aware but what she was enjoying her usual health, Mrs. Marty was stricken just as her daughter-in-law, Mrs. Dietrich Marty, arrived there to make a brief call. While Dr. Blumer was immediately summoned, she had breathed her last before the arrival of the doctor, dissolution evidently having taken place within a few moments after the fatal stroke.

Funeral services were held at the Reformed church this afternoon, with Rev. Muehlmeier officiating.
