


Charles R. Marty

Charles R. Marty, 89, Monticello, died at 5:45 am. today, Tuesday, Oct. 16, 1973, in St. Clare Hospital. He had been a patient there since Aug. 26.

Mr. Marty was a retired farmer. He was born in Adams Township, Green County, Sept. 18, 1884, a son of Charles and Anna Legler Marty. He attended the Loveland rural school. On March 14, 1907, he was married to Bertha Rufer in her parental farm home in Washington Township. Mr. and Mrs. Marty farmed in Washington Township, one-half mile south of the Washington Reformation Church, for 41 years, retiring to Monticello in 1948.



When a member of the Washington Church he had served on the church Consistory. Mr. Marty was a former school board member, had also served on the cheese factory board, and on the church cemetery board.

Surviving are his widow, Bertha; a son, Ivan E. Marty, rural Monticello; three daughters, Mrs. Sam A. (Gladys) Goecks, and Mrs. Gilman (Esther) Schmid, both of rural Monticello, and Mrs. Carl W. (Laura) Wyss, rural Monroe; 11 grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren, and six step-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a son, in 1910, at the age of two; a brother, Henry E., Des Moines, Iowa, Dec. 29, 1960; a sister, Mrs. John (Anna) Moritz, February 1935; a grandson and a step-granddaughter. His father died in November 1932 and his mother, October, 1933.

Funeral services for Mr. Marty will be at 2 pm. Thursday, Oct. 18, in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where he was a member. Rev. Charles G. Workman is to officiate. Burial will be in the Washington Reformation Church Cemetery.
