

Fred C. Marty
July 15, 1884 - Mar. 5, 1963

MONTICELLO — Fred C. Marty, 78, retired Washington Township farmer, died at 7:40 last night in his home of a heart attack.

A native of Washington Township, he had served as Washington town treasurer for 25 years before his retirement to Monticello in 1946. For many years, he was secretary of the Town Hall Dairy Co-op.

He was born July 10 1884, the son of John Casper and Rosina Hefty Marty. He attended the Marty rural school. On Feb. 15, 1906, he was married to Lena Babler, who died Sept. 3, 1938.

Mr. Marty was a member of Washington Reformation church.

Surviving are a son, Lawrence F. at home; two brothers, Edward W., Monticello, and Jacob M. New Glarus, and five sisters, Mmes. Rosa Legler, Robert Holcomb Sr., Ira Holcomb and Sylvia Curtis, all of Monticello, and Louise Gessler, New Glarus.

A sister, Mrs. W. L. Zweifel, New Glarus, and a brother, Walter J. Marty, Belleville, preceded him in death.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Friday in Zwingli United Church of Christ. Rev. J. Allan Mittler, his pastor, will officiate. Burial will be in Highland cemetery.
