

Jost A. Marty

Nov. 30, 1879 - July 9, 1964

Jost A. Marty, 84, Monroe, died early last Thursday morning in the St. Clare hospital, where he had been taken after suffering a broken hip in a fall from a scaffold.

A retired farmer, he was born west of Monticello on Nov. 30, 1879, the son of Jacob and Rose Becker Marty. He attended area rural schools and was married in Monticello on March 8, 1900, to Elizabeth Aebly. They farmed west of Monticello before moving to the Orangeville area. In 1926 they retired and moved to Monroe.

Surviving are his wife; a daughter, Mrs. Fred Wutrich, Clarno; a son, Fred J. Marty, Beloit; seven grandchildren, and 14 great-grandchildren.

A daughter, Marie, a son, Jacob, two sisters and a brother are deceased.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 p. m. Saturday in Shriner-Neushwander funeral home, Monroe. The Rev. Storck, assistant pastor of St. John's church there, officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery, Monroe.
