

Marvin J. Marty
June 22, 1936 – Aug. 27, 1966

Mr. Marty was born June 22, 1936 in Jefferson, the son of M. Albert and M. Eileen Davenport Marty. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1954 and then worked at Paidar interests in Albany. He entered military service on Oct. 23, 1958 and served with the Army in Germany. He was discharged at Ft. Dix, N. J., Oct. 18, 1960.

For the past five years he had worked in Monroe at Triangle Cheese Corp. and Green County Pre-Pak, as maintenance supervisor. .

He was a member of St. James Catholic Church of Dayton.

Surviving are his parents, with whom he lived in Mt. Pleasant township, his fiance, Miss Linda Willborn, Blanchardville; two brothers, Norman J. Marty, Argyle, and David A., Beloit, and a sister, Mrs. Jerry (Joyce) Wittenwyler, Beloit.
