

HILDA S. MILBRANDT

Hilda S. Milbrandt, age 90, of Monticello, died Saturday, December 4, 1999 at the Monroe Manor Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Hilda was born May 18, 1909 in Mt Pleasant Township, Green County, daughter of Robert and Rose (Elmer) Stauffer.

She graduated from Monticello High School in 1928, attended Green County Normal School and taught rural school in Attica, for two years.

She married Harvey M. Milbrandt on October 1, 1930 at the Zwingli Church Parsonage in Monticello. He preceded her in death on August 6, 1994.

Hilda and her husband farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township for many years before moving to Monticello in 1958. Mrs. Milbrandt then worked at the Casino Restaurant, Monticello, and later Roys Sanitary Dairy, Monroe.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, Zwingli Faith Circle, and the Homemakers Club.

Survivors include a daughter, Carol Joy Milbrandt of West Allis; a granddaughter, Julie (Don) Zimmerman, and a great-granddaughter, Nicole Zimmernerman, all of Juda; a sister, Alma Brechlien, Monroe and a brother, Wilbert Stauffer, Monticello.

In addition to her husband, Hilda was preceded in death by a daughter, Marilyn Albright in 1967; two sisters, Louise Robert and Helen Stauffer; and a brother, Herman Stauffer.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, December 9, 1999, at 11:00 am at the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, with Rev. Lawrence Balleine officiating. Interment will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
