Funeral Rites For Mrs. Milbrandt Held Saturday

Funeral services for Mrs. Henry Milbrandt, 46 years old, who passed away at 10 o'clock last Wednesday evening at the Green county home, following a serious illness of about four weeks' duration, were held in Monroe at the Immanuel Evangelical church, Saturday afternoon, Rev. G. H. Blum, pastor of the church, conducted the services.

The deceased was a daughter of of Mr. and Mrs. Frederick Brecklein, having been born in Sylvester township on Dec. 6, 1880. She received her education in the rural school. Her marriage to Henry Milbrandt took place on Feb. 12, 1902. She had always lived in Mt. Pleasant township since her marriage.

Besides her bereaved husband, she is survived by two sons, Harvey and Wilson, both of whom reside at home. A brother, Charles Brecklein, Sylvester township, and a sister, Mrs. William Born, Monroe, also survive. Her mother, Mrs. S. Brecklein, Monroe, succumbed on October 3rd.
