

Carl Miller Dies Suddenly

Aged Citizen of Mt. Pleasant Township Passed Away Saturday.

Nov. 11, 1831 – Feb. 19, 1908

Carl Miller, a well known and highly respected resident of Mt. Pleasant township, passed away very suddenly at his home two and one-half miles east of Monticello at 5 o'clock Saturday afternoon. Mr. Miller had been in poor health for a long time preceding the final summons, but his condition had not been such as to cause the immediate members of his family any alarm until a few hours before his death. Mr. Miller had been under medical treatment for a number of months, but the disease proved unyielding in its nature and this, coupled with his advanced years, made his chances of ultimate recovery very meager.

Mr. Miller was 76 years of age and had been a resident of Green county since 1881, when he arrived here from Germany with his wife and eight children. He was married Nov. 22, 1855, and he is survived by the following children: C. Fred Miller, and Wm. Miller, of Monroe; Frank Miller and Ferdinand Miller, of Juda; Charles Miller, of Sylvester, August Miller, of Mt. Pleasant; Herman Miller, of Tracy, Minn; and Mrs. Ernest Malkow, of Mt Pleasant.

The funeral was held today from the Dutch Hollow church.
