

DIES AFTER OPERATION

Intestinal Obstruction Causes Death of the Little Son of M. Moser

Nov 26, 1899 - May 2, 1906

Mr. and Mrs. Michael Moser, of Exeter township, are mourning the death of their six year old son Johnnie, whose death occurred Sunday night at the Madison general hospital. The little fellow was taken suddenly ill last Tuesday evening with a severe case of intussusception of the intestines and although medical aid was promptly summoned and everything possible was done to alleviate his suffering, his condition grew gradually more alarming until it became apparent that in an operation lay his only chance of recovery. He was accordingly taken to the general hospital at Madison, Friday morning, where he was immediately operated upon by the Drs. Jackson. The case proved to be of such a serious nature, however, that the operation proved of no avail.

The deceased was an unusually bright little fellow and in their great and irreparable loss the grief-stricken parents have the sincere sympathy of all.

The remains were brought from Madison last evening and the funeral was held this afternoon at the German Reformed church in this village. Rev. Carl Heyl conducted the services.
