Gott. Niederhauser, 45, Dies at Postville

Found dead at 9 o'clock yesterday forenoon on the floor of an upstairs room in the Postville cheese factory, about nine miles west of Monticello, Gottfried Niederhauser, aged about 45, a native of Switzerland, was the victim of heart trouble, brought on by blood poisoning of the arm, and the excessive heat.

Mr. Niederhauser, who was a stone mason and brick layer by trade, had resided in the Monticello vicinity off and on for the past number of years. He also at times assisted in cheese factories and had been at the Postville factory for several months.

When Mr. Niederhauser arose in the morning, he was apparently in his usual health and then went upstairs. He was found dead later sprawled out on the floor near his bed.

So as far as is known, Mr. Niederhauser has no relatives in this country.

Final rites were held at 5 o'clock yesterday afternoon at Highland cemetery where burial took place. Rev. A. Muehlmeier officiated.
