John W. Nye, 79, Expires at Attica
Conduct Funeral Services For Aged Resident of County

Funeral services for John William Nye, 79 years of age, well known resident of the Norwegian Settlement for many years, who passed away at his home at about 4 p. m. Friday, were conducted at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon in the home and at 2 in the Attica Methodist church. J. W. Zimmerman, pastor of the Avon Methodist church, officiated. Interment was in the Attica cemetery. A hemorrhage was given as the cause of his unexpected demise.

Born in Verona

He was a son of Louis and Sarah McClarren Nye, having been born in Verona, Dane county, July 25, 1857. On July 12, 1884, he was united in marriage to Ellen Campbell. Upon her death he was married to Charlotte Bartlett July 3, 1886, the ceremony taking place in Albany. For 13 years Mr. Nye made his home in Iowa.

Surviving are a son, John C. Nye, residing near Attica; three daughters, Mrs. Jessie Albertson, near Attica, Mrs. Myrta Popanz, Brodhead, and Mrs. Gertrude Krueger, Marengo, Ill.; one brother, Bert, Newton, Iowa; two sisters, Mrs. Helen Swann, Bouton, Iowa, and Mrs. Jessie Fitzgerald, Plover, Iowa. A son, Chauncey, passed away some time ago.

Mr. Nye was a member of the Attica Methodist Episcopal church.
