

Bernice Pfeuti

June 11, 1908 - Sept. 23, 1983

Mrs. Walter (Bernice) Pfeuti, 75, of Mount Pleasant Township, Rt. 1, Albany, died Friday, Sept. 23, 1983 at 5 a.m. at St. Clare Hospital after a brief illness.

Born on the Rhyner homestead farm June 11, 1908, the former Bernice Ruth Rhyner was the daughter of Jacob and Sarah Freitag Rhyner.

She attended Smiley rural school and the Green County Normal.

She later taught at Smiley School for three years and was married in Monticello, on June 11, 1930 to Walter Pfeuti.

After their marriage they farmed near Albany for the last 47 years and resided in Mt. Pleasant Township.
