Barbara Louise Pluss Passes Away at Age of 16

Mr. and Mrs. John Pluss, of Mt. Pleasant township mourn the death of their eldest daughter, Barbara Louise Pluss, whose death occurred on Saturday, June 2, following an illness of only a few days' duration. The deceased was taken ill a week ago last Friday with what appeared to be a mild case of measles. She was apparently getting along nicely until a short time before the end, when pneumonia developed and her condition became so grave that the tenderest of care and the best of medical attention proved unavailing.

Miss Pluss was a native of this vicinity, having been born in Washington township on Dec. 31, 1907. Since the family moved to Mt. Pleasant township she had attended the Silver school and had just graduated from the grades when stricken with her final illness. She was a girl who was possessed of a bright and sunny disposition and will be greatly missed by her schoolmates and many other friends in the neighborhood.

She is survived by her parents, two brothers and five sisters. In the great sorrow that has overtaken them, the bereaved family have the sympathy of all.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 1:15 at the home and at 2 o'clock at the Reformed church, the Rev. A. Muehlmeier officiating. The services were largely attended by relatives and friends of the bereaved family and many beautiful floral offerings were in evidence. Burial was in Highland cemetery.
