Paul M. Purintun, 74, a former Mt. Pleasant Township resident, died at Sartori Memorial Hospital, Cedar Falls, Iowa, on June 11. He was born Jan. 1, 1905, at Monticello, the son of the late Charlie and Katie Sylvester Purintun. On June 21, 1940, he was married to Pearl Arnold at Hazel, S.D. The couple farmed in Iowa for 18 years and later opened the Purintun Nursing Home in Everly, Iowa. They operated the home until 1966, and moved to Cedar Falls.

Mr. Purintun was employed at the Western Home. Preceding him in death were a son, Roger and a brother, Frank, who both died in infancy, his parents, and a sister Helen Bubb, Plymouth, Wis.

He was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church of Cedar falls where funeral services were held Thursday, June 14, with burial in Cedar Memorial Gardens.
