

Henry Rhyner
June 9, 1893 - Dec. 28, 1971

Henry Rhyner, 78, a native of Mt. Pleasant Township, died at noon Tuesday, Dec. 28, in the Green County Hospital. He had been in failing health many years and was previously at the Dane County Home, near Verona.

He was born June 9, 1893, a son of Henry and Euphemia Rhyner Rhyner. He attended Babler rural school, near his home on Wis. 39 where he farmed a number of years.

He was the last of the family. The only immediate survivors are an uncle, John S. Rhyner, Brooklyn; an aunt, Mrs. Rachel Klossner, Rice Lake, and first cousins.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Miss Anna Rhyner, Albany, Nov. 27, 1960; a brother, Samuel, Monroe, Dec. 3, 1966; his mother, Nov. 2, 1945, and his father in 1924.

Funeral services will be at 1:30 p.m. Friday, Dec. 31, in Memorial Lounge of the Zwingli United Church of Christ at Monticello. Rev. Charles Workman of Zwingli Church is to officiate. Burial will be there in Highland Cemetery.
