Jane Ann Rieder, 16, Succumbs, Rites Held At Zwingli Saturday

Funeral services for Miss Jane Ann Rieder, 16 years of age, Mt. Pleasant township, who passed away at 5 p. m. Wednesday at University Hospital, Madison, shortly after arriving there from the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, were held at 11 Saturday morning at the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, church pastor, officiated, and interment was in Highland cemetery here. Pallbearers were Tom Durtschi, Steven Mitschele, Albany, Richard Gruenewald, Juda, Geoffrey Legler, Jack Stenbrotten, Monticello, and Ronald Thomm, Monroe.

The deceased had been admitted to the St. Clare hospital on several occasions during the fall of 1964. She was readmitted to St. Clare on May 3 and was transferred to Madison Wednesday afternoon.

Miss Rieder, a sophomore student at the Monticello high school, had been in poor health for a number of years.

She was born in Monroe Dec. 30, 1948, the daughter of Frederick and Hulda Aeschlimann Rieder. The family moved to Mt. Pleasant township in 1960. She attended the Babler rural school.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ and was confirmed there in 1964. She was a member of the Silver View 4-H club and played in the Monticello high school band when her health permitted.

She is survived by her parents: one brother, Paul Frederick. at home: the maternal grandparents: Mr. and Mrs. John Aeschlimann, Route 1, Juda; the paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. John Rieder, Route 2, Monroe: paternal great-grandfather, Fred Dettwiler, Monroe, and the paternal great-grandmother, Mrs. Anna Rieder, in Switzerland.
