

ARDYS CHLOE RIESE
July 29, 1904 - Nov. 11, 1974

Mrs. Frank E. Riese, 70, Monticello, died at 8: 15 am today. Monday, Nov. 11, 1974, in St. Clare Hospital after a long illness. She was hospitalized on Oct. 27, the fifth time in a two-year period.

The former Ardys Chloe Wallom was born in Monticello July 29, 1904, a daughter of Edwin and Sidney Brayton Wallom. She graduated from Monticello High School in 1924 and worked many years as a telephone operator at the Monticello Exchange of the United Telephone Co. On Nov. 1934, she was married, in Freeport, Ill., to Frank E. Riese. Her death occurred the day before their 40th wedding anniversary.

Mrs. Riese was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and Grace Mission Circle of the former EUB Church.

Surviving are her husband, Frank, a son. Edward A., Rt. 1, Monticello; a brother, Claude B. Wallom, and a sister, Mrs. A. W. (Mary) Peterson, both of Monticello, and three grandchildren. David Riese, a West Point Cadet, and Kris and Bryon Riese.

She was preceded in death by a son, Wilbert, in 1938, and her parents.

Funeral services will be at 130 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 14, in Zwingli Church. Her pastor, Rev. Charles G. Workman, is to officiate. Burial is to be in Highland Cemetery.
