

## **Magdeline Rothlisberger**

**Dec. 11, 1866 - 1936**

### **Mrs. Rothlisberger Dies From Sickness Funeral Rites Conducted For Well Known Resident**

Funeral services for Mrs. Magdeline Rothlisberger, 69 years of age, a native of Switzerland, who died late Saturday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Jacob Blum, of this village, following an illness of several years' duration, were conducted at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon in the home and at 2 in the Reformed church.

Rev. A. Muehlmeier, pastor of the church, officiated. Interment was in Highland cemetery.

A native of Switzerland, Magdeline Christopher was born at Krauchtal, Canton Bern, Dec. 11, 1866. She came to the United States in 1920, first settling in Michigan. Later she made her home in Milwaukee until the past two years or more, during which time she was cared for at the homes of relatives.
