Frances M. Schlittler, age 84 of Monticello, died Friday March 5, at home. She was born in rural Monroe on Nov. 30, 1914 to Fred and Bertha (Keller) Blumer. She graduated from Albany High School class of 1932. She went on to Nurses Training at Evangelical Deaconess Hospital in Monroe. On March 22, 1938 she was married at the Albany Baptist Church Parsonage to Edwin M. Schlittler.
