Helen M. Schlittler, age 74, of Monroe, died Tuesday, August 3, 1999 at St. Mary's Hospital, Madison, following a short illness.

Helen was born December 22, 1924 in Cadiz Township, the daughter of Jess and Hattie (Butts) Metcalf. She attended Franklin Rural School and married Carl Schlittler on December 17, 1944 at St. John's Church, Monroe.
