Inez R. (Inie) Schultz, age 74, of Janesville, formerly of Monroe, died Tuesday, March 28, 2000 at her home.

Inez was born October 5, 1925 in Washington Township, Green County, Wisconsin, daughter of John and Edna (Zimmerman) Schuler. She graduated from Monticello High School in 1944 and married LeRoy A. Schultz on November 16, 1944 at the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed Church in Monticello. Following their marriage they lived in Neenah, Niagara, and Kimberly, Wisconsin before moving to Monroe in 1969.
