

## **Albert Schulz**

**July 23, 1869 – April 12, 1954**

### **Rites Set Today For Albert Schulz, 84 Mt. Pleasant**

Albert Schulz, 84 years of age, highly esteemed Mt. Pleasant township farmer, passed away at his home, about three miles east of Monticello, at 9:30 Monday morning from the effects of a heart condition.

Mr. Schulz had been in failing health for the past six months.

#### **Native of Germany**

Mr. Schulz was a native of Germany and was born at Noerenberg, July 23, 1869, the son of August and Louise Sarber Schulz. He attended school in Germany and came to America in 1884. He came directly to Green county and settled on the farm where he spent the rest of his life.

In 1911 Mr. Schulz returned to Germany and was married there on Feb. 12, 1912, to Hedwig Ruenger. They came to America the same year. Mrs. Schulz died in 1950.

Surviving are one son, Herman, on the home farm: four daughters, Mrs. Dale Atkinson and Mrs. Harold Albertson, Albany; Mrs. Howard Gould, Belleville, and Mrs. Lawrence Huntley, Monticello; one brother, Otto, Belleville; and 14 grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife and one daughter, Ella, in 1935; two brothers in Germany and one brother, August, Monticello, in 1944; and one sister, Mrs. John Hutsel, Albany, in 1951.

Mr. Schulz was a member of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.

#### **Funeral Services Today**

Funeral services will be held at 2 this (Thursday) afternoon in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church. The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, church pastor, will officiate, and burial will be in the adjoining church cemetery.
